

WEBSITE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

COOKIES

What are cookies?

Cookies are harmless text files that web servers can store on your computer's hard drive when you visit a website. They allow the server to recognize you when you revisit. These files hold small amounts of data and allow the server to recognize you when you revisit a website.

Why we use Cookies

We use cookies on our Site to gain insight into how our visitors use the Site and to improve our Site service and to contribute to research and analytics studies, including the use of artificial intelligence and machine learning. Internet cookies are common and do not harm your system – they just store or gather site information. They help you do things online, like remembering login details so you don't have to re-enter them when revisiting a site.

How we use Cookies

We use cookies to:

- Gather customer journey information on our public site only.
- Temporarily store input information in our calculators, tools, illustrations and demonstrations.
- Store details for marketing to you, product preferences to improve our targeting and enhance your journey through our site.
- Evaluate our sites' advertising and promotional effectiveness (we own the anonymous data collected and don't share it with anyone).

We don't use cookies to track people's internet usage after leaving our sites and we don't store personal information in them that others could read and understand. We will not sell or distribute cookie information without your prior consent.

What cookies do we use?

We use both:

- Session cookies – a session cookie (also called a transient cookie) is temporary and will be erased once you close your browser (session cookies will not gather information from your computer, but they will recognize you and you navigate between pages during your session and will help maintain security during your visit); and
- Persistent cookies – persistent cookies are permanent cookies that have set expiration dates, they are stored on your device until they expire or are deleted and they will collect information such as your login details or user preferences when you visit certain websites.

Cookies can also be either:

- First-party cookies – a first-party cookie is owned and created by the Site you are visiting and stores a small amount of text on your computer (first-party cookies are usually allowed by most web browsers, but if you should choose to disable these type of cookies, the Site you are visiting will not be able to track your activity during the navigation), or
- Third-party cookies – third-party cookies are created and owned by a website other than the one you are currently visiting, these cookies will usually be from a company providing a service to the owners of the website you are visiting and these type of cookies typically store tracking information and personal preferences.
